Day and Night Meetings

"Token & Trifles Perforated Paper Projects"

The May program for both the day and night meeting will be a choice of two little projects worked on perforated paper shapes from Token & Trifles (or you can choose to work them both.)

The FIRST PROJECT is a snowman ornament. You will provide the threads and ribbons. The kit will include white paper shapes, needle and instructions at a cost of \$10.

Materials required:

DMC floss:

- ❖ 321 Red
- ❖ 503 Blue Green
- ❖ 3865 White
- ❖ 3799 Charcoal
- ❖ 760 Pink
- ❖ 3819 Green
- ❖ 783 Gold
- ❖ One 8" length of 1/8" satin ribbon for a hanger in your choice of color (I used white)
- ❖ 1 yd. 4mm silk ribbon to match or contrast the paper for whipping the two paper pieces together (I used white)



The SECOND PROJECT is a scissor holder and needlebook set. You will provide the threads, ribbons and wool felt for the needlebook page. The kit for the scissor holder will include white paper shapes, needle and instructions at a cost of \$8 for the scissor holder and \$10 for the needlebook.



Materials Required:

- 5 yards thread of your choice—overdyed threads are great for this. The pattern showed it in red; I chose to do mine in purple (surprise, surprise). It shouldn't be too thick of a thread as the paper is 20 count. You may want to use some metallic thread to sparkle it up a bit. I used #4 braid in a coordinating color (less than 1 spool will do the job).
- One 2"x3" piece of doctor's flannel or wool felt for needlebook page
- 1 yd. 4mm silk ribbon in coordinating or contrasting color for needlebook; 3 yards of the same ribbon for scissor holder. (These are estimates. I used had left over ribbon from one 4 yd. package of ribbon).
- 4"x6" piece of card stock for scissor holder lining
